Ann Arbor, Michigan (September 11, 2007) – With growing popularity of Wi-Fi enabled laptops and PDAs many people would like to access the Internet while away from home. Once you have your Wi-Fi enabled computer or PDA you are ready to go. Whether you need to keep up with e-mail for business or simply chat with a friend, TLC Eyecare & Laser Centers allows you to do it while away from home or the office when visiting the Doctor or having a procedure.

TLC Eyecare & Laser Centers now offers Wi-Fi service to our patients. All of the TLC Eyecare & Laser Centers are Wi-Fi ready this includes all of our Michigan and Ohio center locations. Wi-Fi, or wireless fidelity, connectivity typically takes place through access points, or “hot spots,” that use unregulated frequencies in the same spectrum as appliances such as microwaves and most cordless home phones. Wi-Fi access can be set up by searching the network inside the TLC center, while visiting our centers if you need help executing please ask one of our front desk personnel for assistance, this is a convenient way to connect to the internet, access e-mail or connect to a corporate network using a wireless device.

Wi-Fi speeds can vary depending on factors such as signal quality from the hot spot's access point, distance from the hot spot and how many people are using it at a particular time. Average Wi-Fi speeds are faster than dial up, ranging up to 5 megabits per second between the access point and the Wi-Fi enabled device.
